★ FACING FREEDOM IN AMERICA

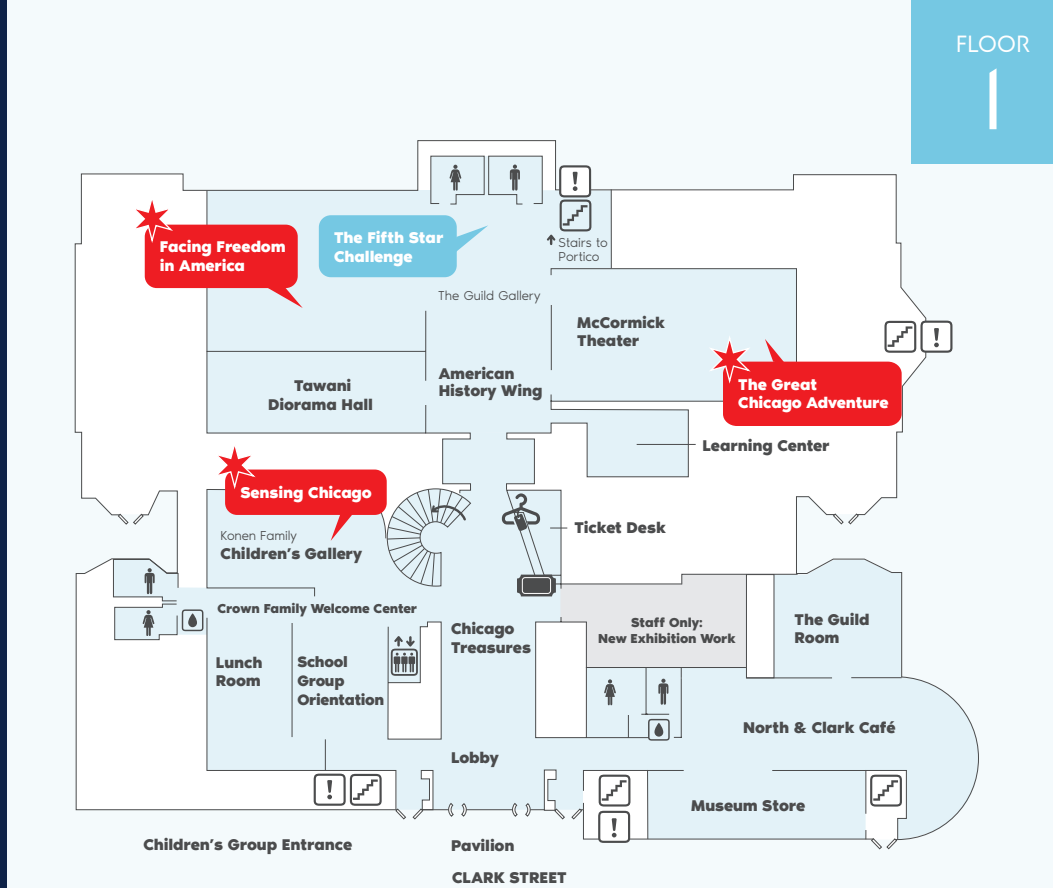
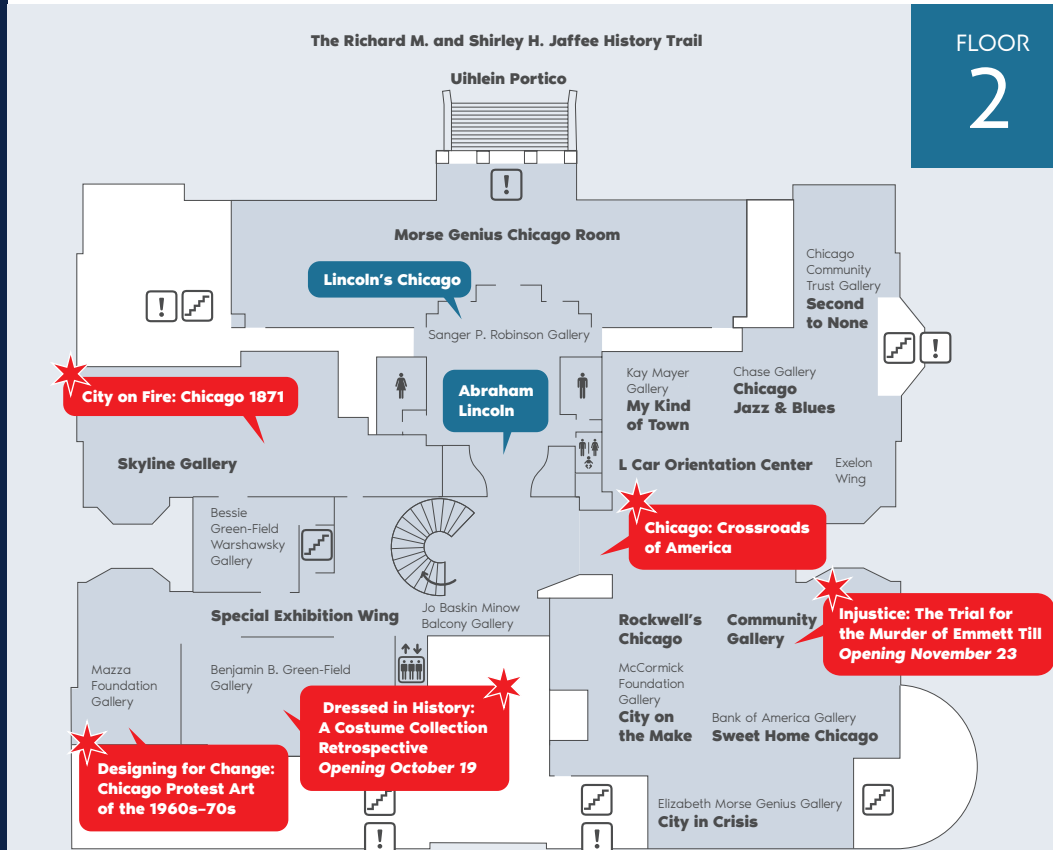
