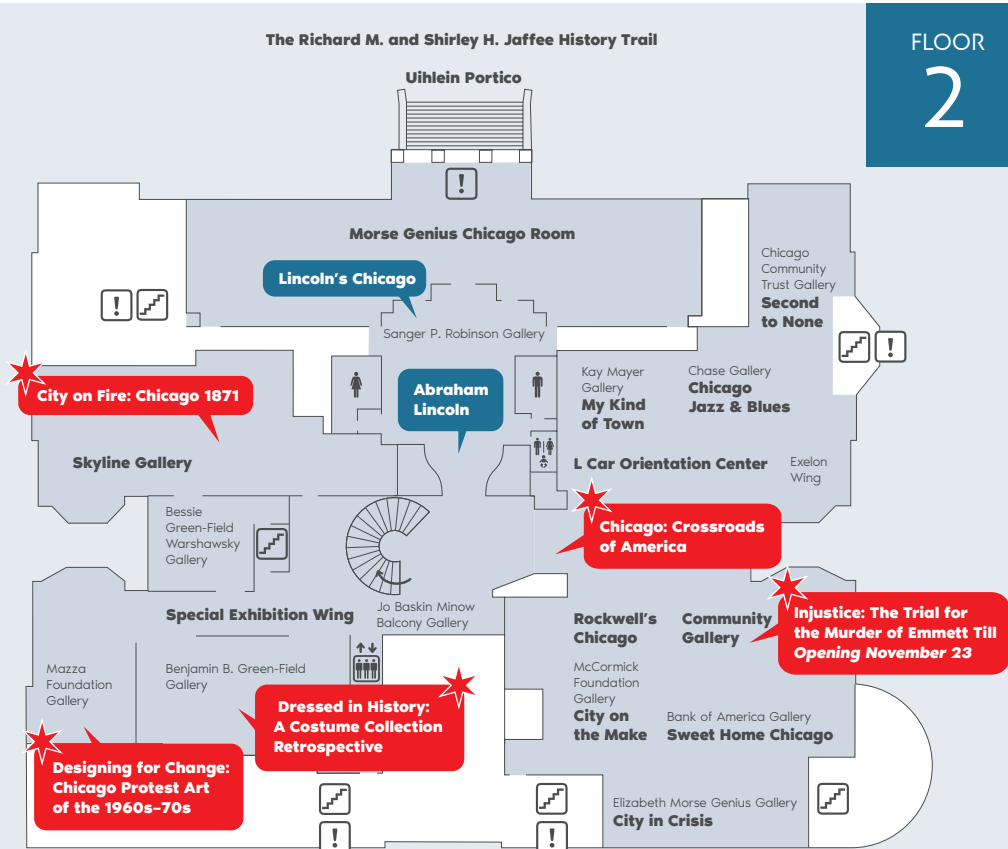

## ★ FACING FREEDOM IN AMERICA

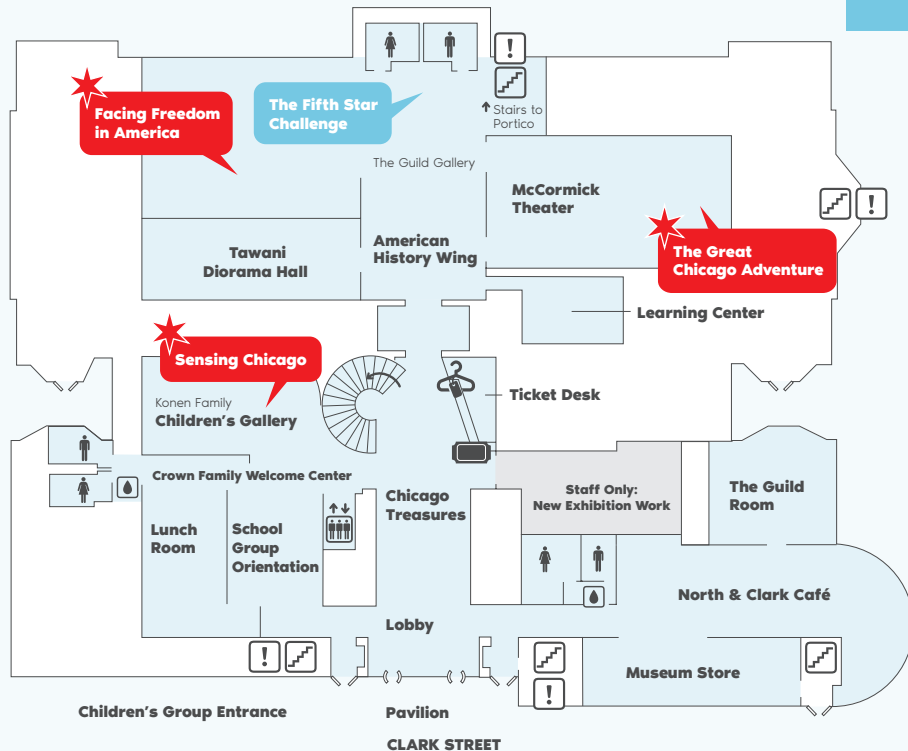
