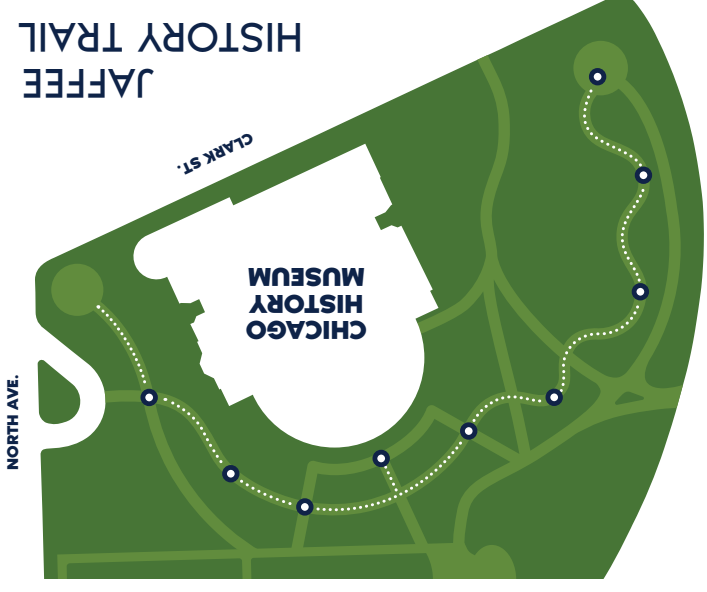

## ★ FACING FREEDOM IN AMERICA

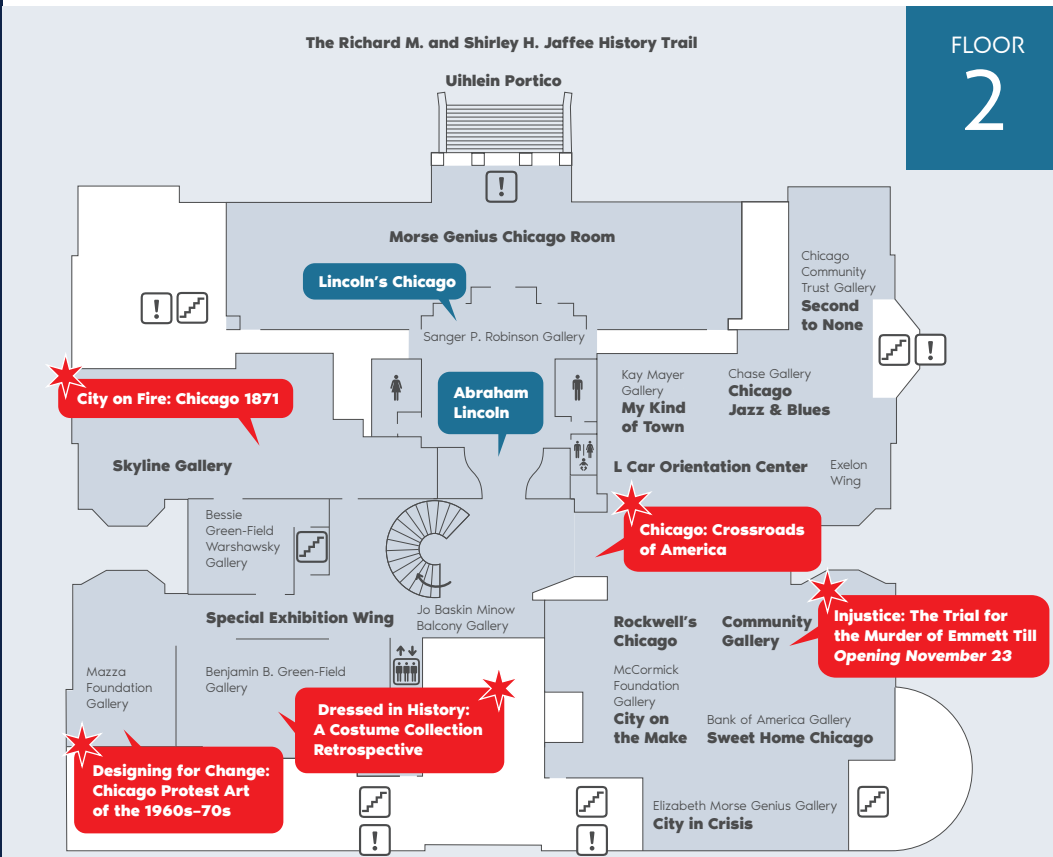

## ★ THE GREAT CHICAGO ADVENTURE

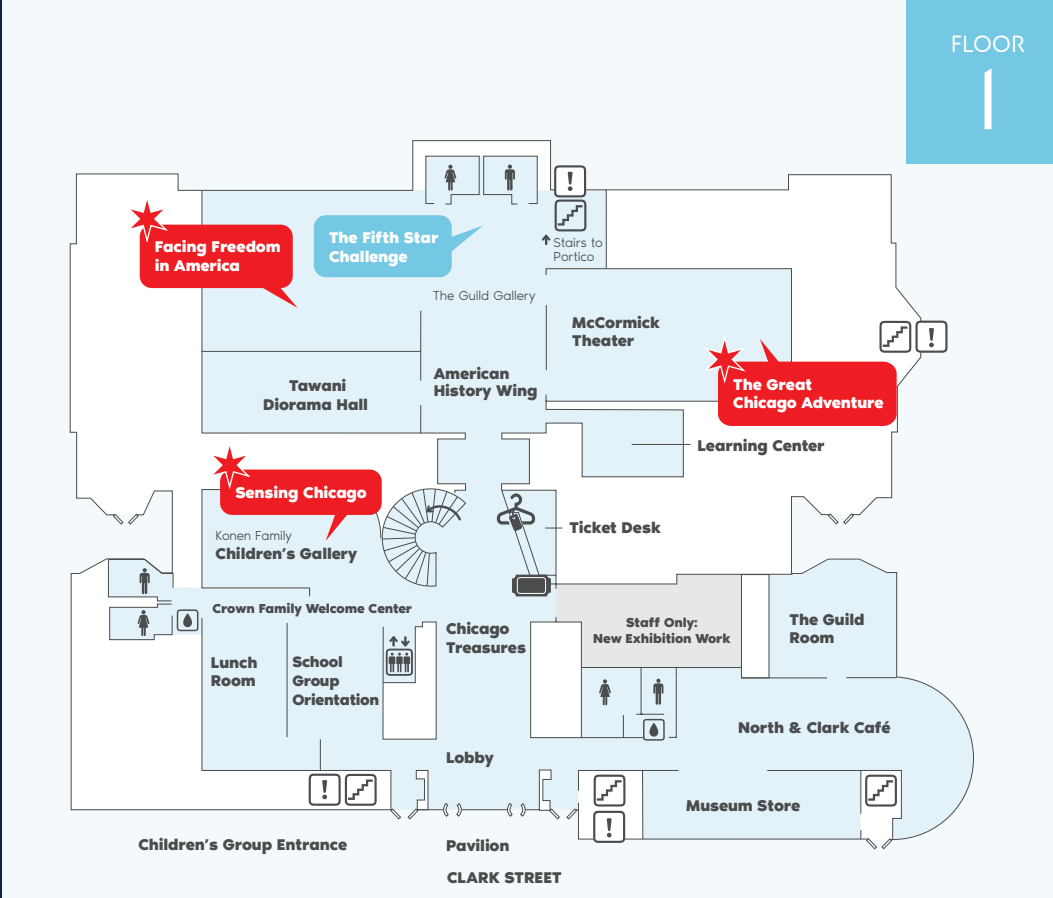
